Because we are all staying safe, the test might happen in the car, or someplace other than a doctor's office.



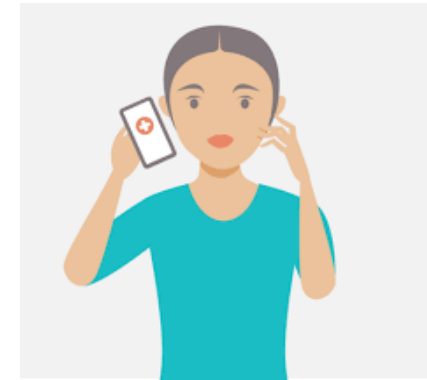
Testing places may be busy and I may need to wait a long time to get my test.
