

Tip Sheet:

Transitions in Early Childhood



Things to consider

- Parents and children often have very different responses to the same transition
- Families' expectations of early care settings may vary
- Families' past experiences with transitions may affect current and future transitions
- Transitions impact children, parents, and professionals. This impact can be both negative and positive and cause emotions of happiness, joy, stress, and/or anxiety
- A family's transition experience may be influenced by their culture, language, and background

- Age and level of development may influence how a child experiences a transition
- Early care settings may differ and create unique demands on a child and their family
