- Large Boxes

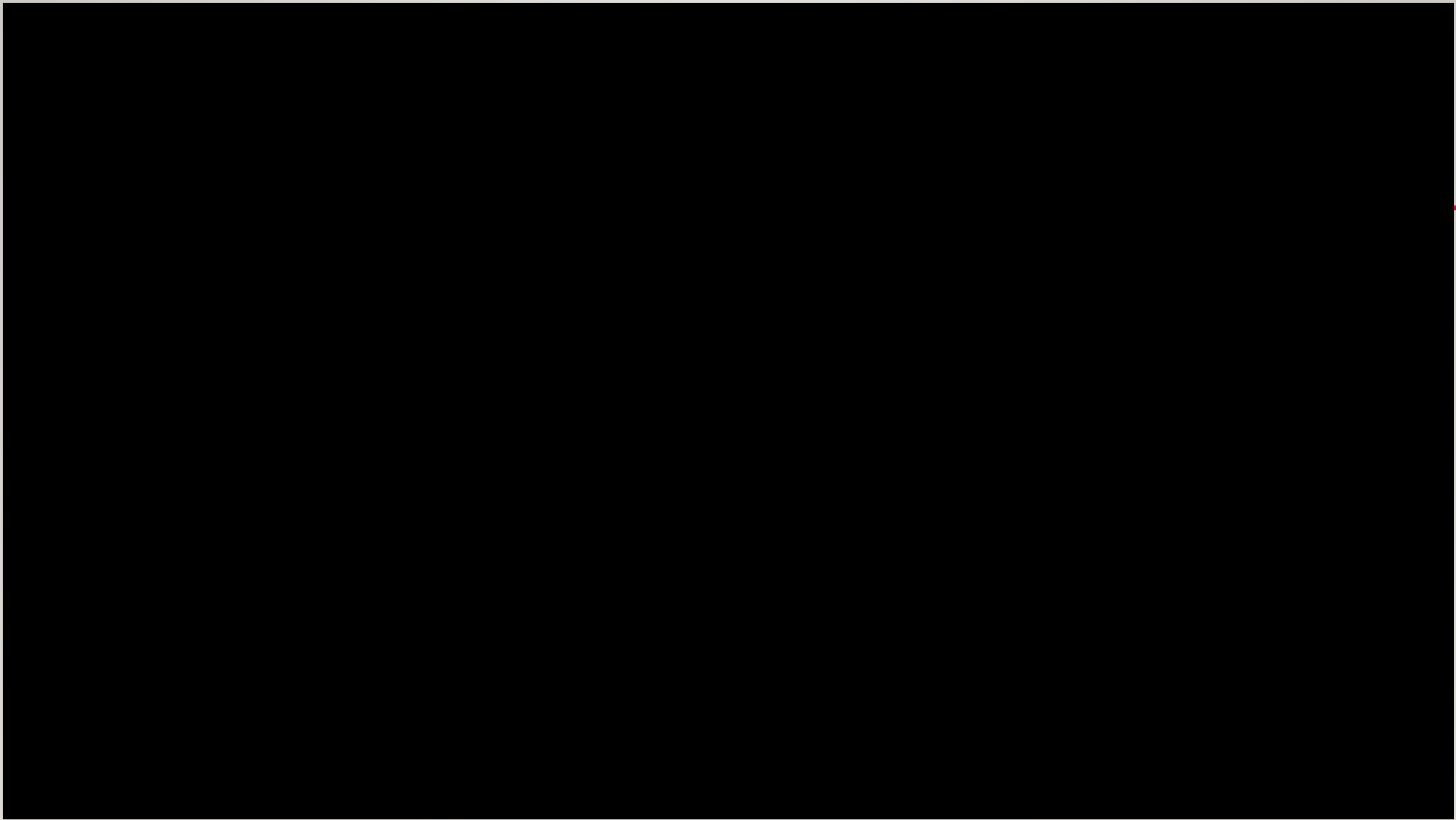


EVERYDAY JUNK RECIPES

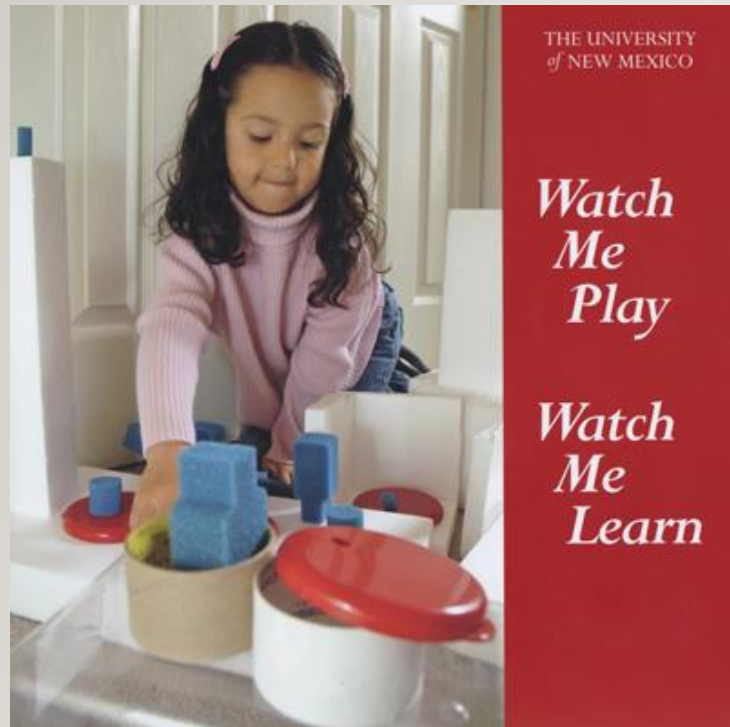
