## **What is Turquoise Care?**

Turquoise Care is the New Mexico
Medicaid Program. Most individuals with
Turquoise Care receive services through
one of four Managed Care Organizations
(MCOs).



### Who qualifies?

To qualify for Turquoise Care, applicants must be U.S. citizens and meet residency and income requirements.
