What is Turquoise Care?

Turquoise Care is the New Mexico Medicaid Program. Most individuals with Turquoise Care receive services through one of four Managed Care Organizations (MCOs).



Who qualifies?

To qualify for Turquoise Care, applicants must be U.S. citizens and meet residency and income requirements.
